

# Accommodation

The facilities of the AKSS Foundation (Anargyrion & Korgialenion School of Spetses) near the traditional settlement of Spetses and the unique pine forest of the foundation – which covers about half of the island and ensures its sustainable development – played a key role in the activities of AKSS, during the period of operation of the School and its boarding school (1928-1983) and during the period that followed.

With gradual upgrades, the facilities have become a magnet for national and international educational and research activities. In addition, the facilities – and in particular the 1100-seat outdoor theater on the adjacent property hill of the Foundation have hosted important cultural activities.
